“Blend Science, Spirituality & Politics for Better Society”: Prof. Dhumal

Abu Road, Jan 19: Prof. Prem Kumar Dhumal, Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh said that if science, spirituality and politics could work together, we could build a better society.

He said this while addressing a huge gathering of 20,000 people from cross sections of society, from all over the world at Brahma Kumaris’ Diamond Hall, Shantivan here today.

He arrived at Brahma Kumaris here yesterday to observe World Peace Day organised by the institution in commemoration of and as a tribute to its founding father Prajapita Brahma who worked for universal peace, harmony and brotherhood and had left his mortal coil on 18th January 1969.

Quoting extensively from the divine discourses delivered last evening through Rajyogini Dadi Hridaya Mohini, Addl. Chief of Brahma Kumaris Prof. Dhumal said in the morning today that spirituality which taught self-less service and doing one’s duty diligently without expectation, was the basis of peace, harmony and happiness in self and society.

He further said that secularism did not mean distancing from ‘religion’ which in true sense meant sticking to one’s core values without neglecting one’s fundamental duties.

Prof. Dhumal who was in Brahma Kumaris Headquarters in Mount Abu and Abu Road for two days attending spiritual lectures and meditation session said that he was feeling completely relaxed, recharged and rejuvenated through the practice and experience of institutions’ rajyoga meditation which he described as an empowering tool to transform people’s negative, vicious and harmful traits into positive, virtuous and healthy ones.
