Self Empowerment Key to Overcome Challenges-Mukul Wasnik

Gurgaon, Feb, 20: **Union Minister for Social Justice & Empowerment, Mr Mukul Wasnik** said “the key to overcome social challenges and to achieve sustainable development lies in attitudinal transformation of especially of managers and controllers of public affairs with their people friendly approach and actions. These can be better achieved, if they empower their inner self with regular practice of spiritual wisdom, positive values and meditation”.
